Definitions:

Leisure: freedom from time-consuming duties, obligations, or activities; time or opportunity for ease, relaxation, etc.

Time when one is not working or occupied; free time

Time which one can spend as one likes, especially when one does not have to work

Leisure is activity – apart from the obligations of work, family, and society – to which the individual turns at will, for either relaxation, diversion, or broadening his knowledge and his spontaneous social participation, the free exercise of his creative capacity.

Leisure Activity: Those activities in which one engages during leisure time. They are usually engaging, positive, and match the strengths of the individual. Leisure activities provide distraction from distress, increase self-esteem, improve mood, and provide structure.
